### Bulletin 1

Welcome and good luck with your club's scrapbook. The Guidelines are on the web site. We are hoping more of you will consider completing your scrapbooks in Digital format this year. Digital can save your club lots of money, while still allowing you to present your club in a fun and creative way.

There was a change in categories last year to resolve the issue of whether a book is 'multimedia' or totally 'handmade'. This year there will only be two categories:

- (1) Traditional (Includes handmade elements and may have digital entries as well.
- (2) Digital (Totally digital creation and printing. It has no additional elements added to the printed page).

As we have presented in the past, a scrapbook is really a historical documentation of what your club has done in a given year. Clubs create scrapbooks for future members to see what the club did during the year. Clubs use photos, news articles, memorabilia from events and journaling to describe events to create unique historical records. Again this year we are asking that clubs further document their history by using a few more pages such as: Title pages, lists of International, State, District and Local officers, department chairs, as well as dates and participants in photos. All work in compiling the scrapbook must be done by club members and only one club year may be included. Your **club name** and **club year** must be on the cover and on the title page. None of the work in the scrapbook may have been entered in any other GFWC-Florida contest such as the Art Contest in the spring. Your Scrapbook must be registered during the times and place designated in the Fall Board Schedule. All Scrapbooks **MUST** be picked up and signed for at the time listed in the Fall Board Schedule. GFWC-Florida will not be responsible for scrapbooks not picked up on time.

Scrapbooks will be judged on artistic presentation, content, merit and completeness. Certificates of participation will be awarded for each entry. A point system has been created and judges will be giving points for each area of judging.

Thank you for participating in the competition and creating a wonderful historical record for your clubs. We are very excited about these changes and look forward to seeing your creations at Fall Board.
